It is with regret the Ladies Auxiliary of Somerset Aerie has decided to surrender their charter. It has been a good run for 70+ years.





### Secretary's Corner

**Dear Brothers and Sisters.** 

One of the most important components of a healthy Aerie is a growing membership base. New members are vital to the long term success of any organization. Eve-



ry member can do something for their Aerie by sponsoring new members. The Fraternal Order of Eagles has a specific multi-step process that must be followed. I thought I would detail that process to help facilitate member participation. It all begins when a member sponsors someone either as a first or second proposer on their application. The proposers should make sure the application is filled out completely (back and front) and of course is legible. There is a receipt portion of the application for the \$20.00 application fee that should be filled out and given to the applicant. Once I receive the application it is read off on the floor at our next Regular Aerie Meeting. There is an updated list of all proposed members and their sponsors that is posted in The Social Room. Once this is done each proposed member receives a letter explaining that they must arrange to be interviewed by The Interviewing Committee. Once an applicant is interviewed it is reported to the membership at our next Regular Aerie Meeting at which point

all members in attendance who wish to ballot on the applicant can either vote to accept or reject them for membership. Upon election to membership the candidate receives a second letter informing them that they may come to any Regular Meeting and be initiated into The Order. The letter also explains that special arrangements can be made by The Worthy President should an elected candidate have difficulty attending Regular Aerie Meetings. Another very important bit of information in the letter specifically states that an elected candidate has six months to be initiated into The Order or their application is voided, their application fee is forfeited and they

must reapply for membership. I hope this information is helpful and I encourage sponsoring members to stay engaged in the process with their proposed candidate to ensure a smooth transition from applicant to member.

And remember, new members today mean future success for Somerset Aerie #2137.
